#### PROJECT COMPLETION

Tower Arctic would like to thank all residents for welcoming us and trusting us during the 2018-2021 working seasons. It has been a pleasure to be part of this adventure with the community of Pond Inlet.

The Pond Inlet Marine Infrastructure built for the community is composed of the east and west breakwaters, a laydown area, a sealift ramp, a small craft float and a shoreline access surface preparation connecting all these components. The construction phase of the project is now completed, and the Department of Economic Development and Transportation will operate the facilities.

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## Operation of the Small Craft Harbour:

- Every year, the floats will have to be installed back on the float pad and uninstalled once the open water season is done. This will need to be done in consideration of ice conditions.
- Residents will no longer have to move equipment out of the way of construction activities.
- There are two ladders on the wharf that will be installed every year for safety purposes.
- These arrangements will be made by the Department of Economic Development and Transportation.



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#### Future Use of the Quarry and Haul Road:

- Part of the quarry closure, as approved by the Hamlet, includes the positioning of yellow and red flags all around the quarry pit for safety purposes. Access has been closed by the placement of boulders. Residents should not trespass these signs due to safety risks
- The Haul Road will become the responsibility of the Hamlet. Safe use of the road by any vehicles, personnel or residents is now the responsibility of the Hamlet.

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### **Tower Arctic Equipment Demobilization and Winterization**

- The Tower Arctic's crawler crane will be temporally stored on the Small Craft Harbour laydown for the upcoming year and will be fully demobilized using the 2022 sealifts.
- The others equipment and material will be stored at the Tower Arctic's garage site along the Haul Road.
